# JAMTARA WILDERNESS CAMP

**MADHYA PRADESH** Combining attention to detail with simple living, this camp is your gateway to Pench

If you're visiting Pench National Park and are looking for an exclusive jungle experience Jamtara Wilderness Camp close to the Karmakhiri gate is a perfect choice. Open from October to April every year, the camp offers 10 luxury tents that don't compromise on comfort, but that take their inspiration from the rugged surroundings.

Working closely with conservationists, the camp management ensures that its ecological footprint is light, with service that is still top-notch. Ask the property to arrange for jeep safaris into Pench to spot wildlife, which includes leopards, tigers, wild dogs accompanied by articulate naturalists who will bring the jungle alive around you.

## HOTEL ESSENTIALS

The plush accommodations consist of ten luxury tents that make up the camp are located in their own private thicket, with patios that look out to the nature outside. Roll up the front panels to bring the outside in, and if you're feeling adventurous sleep under the stars in a star bed. Back at the lodge, the tent with wooden flooring and comfortable linens is your private sanctuary which will have you forget that you are in the outskirts of a jungle. The common area includes the lounge, swimming pool, library and dining area. Cuisine at the lodge leans towards freshly prepared Indian fare, made with



locally grown vegetables. If you have an afternoon free, visit the local village to get a glimpse of rural India and its challenges living close to a wildlife park.

## GETTING THERE

The closest big city is Nagpur, from which the camp is a three-hour drive away. Jabalpur is another option that is four hours away, and if you are flying in on private charter, the Seoni Airstrip is the closest option.
